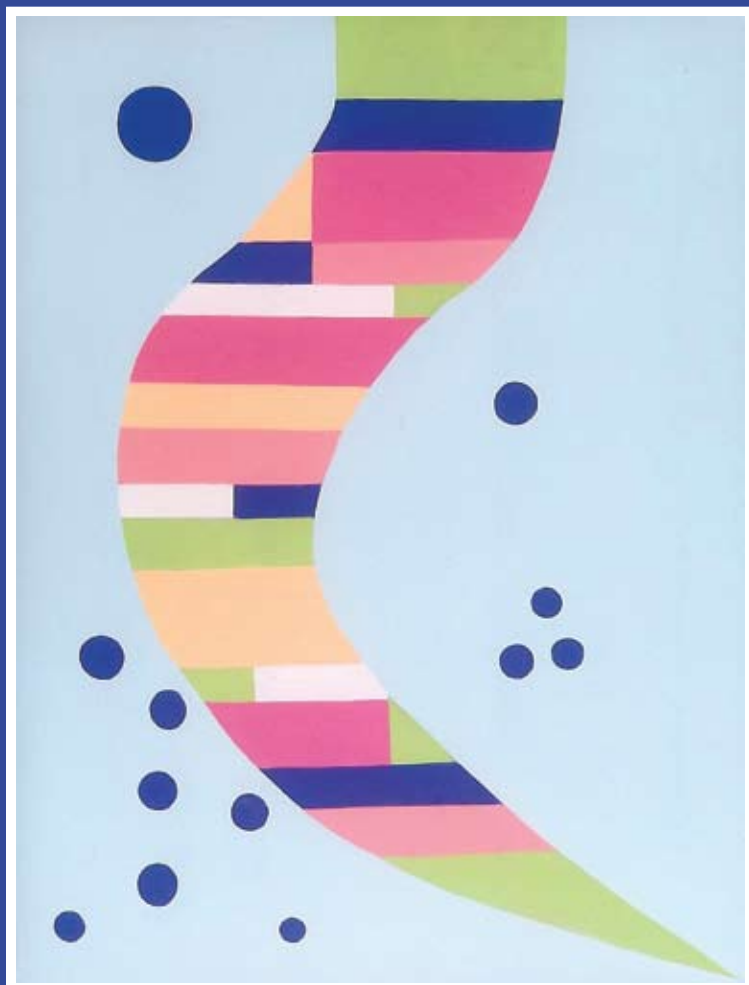


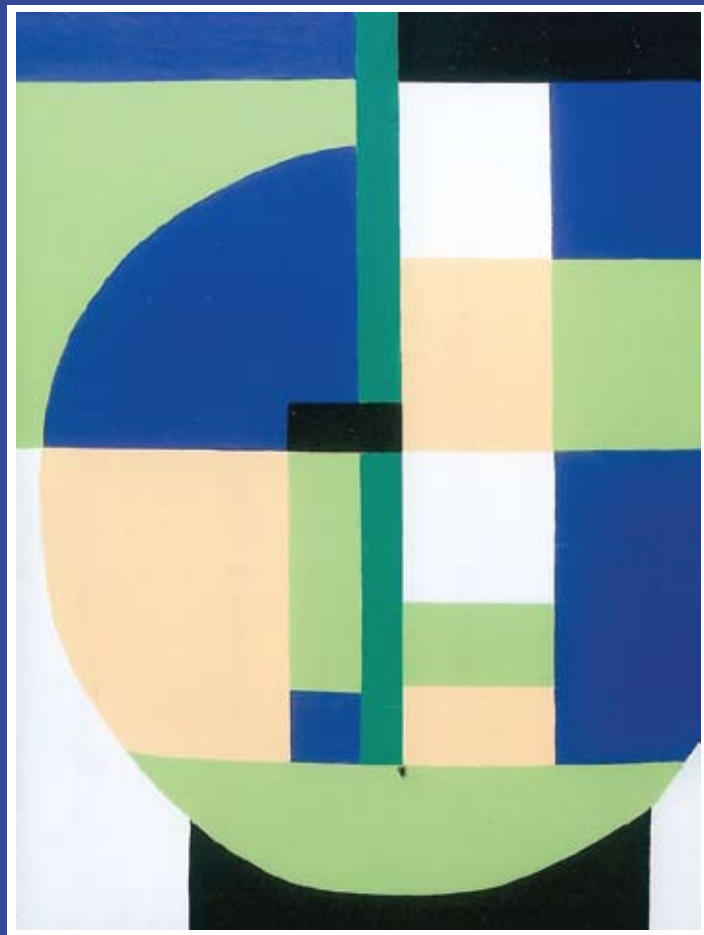
# DIANE HOLLAND
